The main aim of the organization is to help the Indian students develop academically, culturally and socially. We being a group administrated by interested TU Chemnitz students and alumni confined to Chemnitz region, but still we have evolved during the past few years. We have successfully organized many events for integrating the Indian students and also broadcasting Indian culture to International Students and Locals.

The following are the contributions of ICC towards Indian student community which have outgrown from a small group of 15 in 2008 to 1600 students till date.

- One of them is **USG CHEMNITZ CRICKET CLUB** established in 2014 by Indian students and researchers. Since 2014 this sports club actively organizing youth training camps including locals, Internationals and refugees every two months.
- Conducting a successful event "**GLIMPSES OF INDIA 2016**" portraying the diverse Indian culture and tradition.



Academic

The growing numbers of Indian students at the Technical University necessitates a sustainable cross-linking of the already existing offers as well as the introduction of new formats that altogether ensure study success, enhance attractively of the university and enrich academic life on the campus for Indian students.

- One of the members of ICC is currently working under the project sponsored by the ESF which aims at the conceptual development and practical promotion of academic integration of international students under a special consideration of differences between national educational systems, learning cultures and scientific traditions.

- “**SARALON GmBH**” being one of the spinoff of TU Chemnitz started by two Indian and together with two Germans, is also located near the University campus.

FINANCIAL BUDGET

ICC is a non-profit organization run by Indian Students and Researchers to promote Indian Culture and heritage in Chemnitz. We don't have an annual budget for the ICC rather we have individual budgets allotted by Studentwerk, StuRa and TU Chemnitz to organize Cultural Fest. One of the Annual Fest i.e. Diwali caters a crowd of 900 -1200 Invites has a total budget of 12,000 € is been organized every year since 2008. There are few events like Ganesh Chaturthi, Independence Day, Holi and Yoga Day which are organized by contributions from fellow Indians. Chemnitz Cricket Team generate fund from membership fee. Some Events are also sponsored and supported by Indian Restaurants in Chemnitz.
